

ORDINANCE NO. 1719

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-302 OF THE NORTON CITY
CODE RELATING TO ELECTRIC UTILITY POINT OF DELIVERY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1: Section 15-302 of the Code of the City of Norton is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-302: POINT OF DELIVERY

It is the policy of the City to own, operate and maintain the electric distribution facilities up to the point of delivery. This policy is applicable to services rendered either overhead or underground. The point of delivery is the point where the City's electric distribution facilities are first connected to the electric facilities of the customer. All such facilities will be installed in accordance with the City's Line Policy and the current National Electric Code at the time of the installation. The point of delivery for the various classification of services is shown as follows:

1. Overhead Service Residential/Commercial:

Point where the City's facilities are first connected to the electric facilities of the customer, typically 24" from the line side of the weatherhead.

2. Underground Service:

For residential customers (excluding multiple-metered installations), the customer will furnish, install, own and maintain the underground service duct from the customer's house or meter pedestal (for mobile homes) to the City's padmount transformer, pullbox or service enclosure. The City will furnish, install, own and maintain the service conductors in the duct. The City will own and maintain all structural facilities for secondary conductors up to and including the service enclosure.

For commercial and industrial customers (including multiple-metered residential installations), the customer will furnish, install, own and maintain all facilities (service duct and service conductors) beyond the point of delivery (City's padmount transformer, pullbox or service enclosure) to the customer's building.

Section 2: Any ordinance in conflict with the above amendment shall hereby be amended to reflect this change.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of publication in the official city newspaper.
